Situation: The UNC BOG Committee on Strategic Initiatives is focused this academic year on

understanding enrollment trends and the related fiscal outlook. The ECU Board of Trustees is similarly focused and begins a three-part series of related session with this

joint meeting.

With the arrival of the enrollment cliff, increased competition, changing student mix, and evolving workforce needs, it is important institutions have a multi-pronged

strategy for new student acquisition, student success, and fiscal health.

**Background:** Multiple factors influence enrollment outcomes so an understanding of the overall

landscape, trends, and forecasts along with ECU's market position, informs the priorities and practices to best position ECU in this competitive environment.

**Assessment:** The committees will receive a three-part series on the enrollment landscape and the

factors and drivers of ECU's strategic enrollment management strategy.

The first session will focus on phase two of the UNC System Performance Metrics and

the linkages to ECU's student success agenda and fiscal health planning.

The second session will provide an overview of ECU's strategic enrollment

management plan, and an analysis with strategic action plans and related discussion

across three key markets: freshmen, out-of-state, and transfers.

The third session will extend the dialogue on four related aspects: graduate

enrollments, PKH, scholarships, and branding.
